BORING TO READ BUT IMPORTANT TO KNOW

WORKING SPOTS:

A handler may only work one dog.

Dogs **MUST** have titled in NW2 or above. If you compete in a venue other than NACSW, please contact Lisa Basial to discuss your suitability for a Working Spot.

Because Walt is judging our trial that weekend, a handler may not **WORK** a dog competing in the May 27-28 NACSW trial at Hartman Center in Milroy, PA, but may **AUDIT** the clinic or **WORK** a dog in the clinic that is not competing in our trial that weekend.

Search areas will be quite a distance from the parking areas – crating in/from your car is not feasible. Handlers should bring a portable crate and dogs should be comfortable (& non-disruptive) in a crate while waiting for their turn. If a dog cannot be crated, the handler should expect to stage away from the search areas and will not be able to watch other working teams.

The clinic will take place in a public park, and the search environments will mimic real-life conditions. There will be people and dogs in the area that are not working in or auditing the clinic (all auditors will be human). Please consider this when deciding whether to apply for a Working Spot, and be prepared to work through distractions as necessary.

Working Spots are limited – applying for a Working Spot does not guarantee acceptance. In the event of cancellations, preference for Working Spots will be given to those registered for Auditing Spots.

WHAT TO BRING:

For Everyone - a portable chair; notetaking supplies

For Working Dogs – a portable crate; water/water bowl for your dog; dog clean up supplies; shade supplies, if you desire.

REGISTRATION/OTHER DETAILS:

Working Spots: \$165

Auditing Spots: \$75

Lunch is included in the clinic cost and will be provided by the on-site café. Pre-orders will be taken about a week before the clinic. Water and snacks will also be provided.
